UPDATE MAY 2015

Background

Since 2011, communities have been able to produce a document containing policies to help shape and deliver new development in the local area. This is a neighbourhood plan and the document has to be produced in a specific way. At a public meeting in 2013 residents voted to proceed with a neighbourhood plan. The plan is not being developed by the parish council. Instead, a small group of volunteers are undertaking much of the necessary work. The plan must be approved by a majority of residents in a village referendum.

Current Status

The neighbourhood plan team have obtained the views of residents and village organisations in order to establish the scope of the neighbourhood plan. After further research and debate, the team have identified a number of areas that will be the focus of the plan. The most important of these are...

- Housing Design and Development. Policies relating to housing density, appearance, road safety, and parking solutions.
- Rural Environment. Policies that reflect the previous village design statement and the conservation area appraisal. This part of the plan will also encourage the provision of open spaces and usage of footpaths.
- Community Facilities. Policies that develop or maintain facilities for both young and old, village services and community assets.

Invitation to a Public Meeting

A public meeting will be held at East Markham Village Hall on THURSDAY 11TH JUNE at 7.30pm. All residents are encouraged to attend. After a presentation by the chair of the neighbourhood plan team there will be the opportunity to ask questions and contribute ideas.

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
